III. Criteria of Awards

A. ASOCIO Outstanding Tech Company Award

- **1.** The nominee must be a legally registered local company with technology-related lines of business.
- 2. Proven record of promoting & developing market and innovative products, applications, or technology focusing on Blockchain, IoT, AI, Robotics, Big Data & Cloud-based solutions.
- **3.** Proven capability in promoting technology adoption, expanding digital markets, or contributing to the growth of the tech ecosystem locally and/or regionally.
- **4.** A market leader or model of the industry providing outstanding technology solutions and services that benefit a large number of users.



B. ASOCIO Outstanding Digital Transformation Organization Award

- 1. The nominee must be a legally registered local enterprise or government corporation that primarily operates outside the technology sector but strategically leverages technology to drive transformation and impact.
- **2.** Smart use of technology as a strategic asset that creates extraordinary improvement in operational efficiency and/or costbenefits.
- **3.** Proven capability in promoting technology adoption, expanding digital markets, or contributing to the growth of the tech ecosystem locally and/or regionally.

C. ASOCIO Digital Government Award

- 1. Collaborate with the public sector to implement digital strategies and solutions that significantly improve the service quality to citizens in measurable terms and their business areas.
- **2.** Applying technology to provide ethical and transparent business services to enhance integrity and customer convenience.
- **3.** Deployment of digital services that contribute meaningfully to economic development, enhance social responsibility, and foster digital inclusion.
- **4.** Proven implementation of impactful, well-recognized digital applications in smart city domains, such as intelligent transportation, public safety, urban planning, e-health, smart utilities, or environmental sustainability.

D. ASOCIO Talent Development Award

- 1. Legally registered organizations actively engaged in human resource (HR) development, talent cultivation, or education-related activities include universities, colleges, professional training institutes, government corporations, and public sector agencies.
- 2. Demonstrated excellence in human resource and digital talent development initiatives, including innovative curriculum design, training methodologies, and educational technologies.
- **3.** Proven outstanding achievements in bridging academic learning and practical application, through initiatives such as internships, cooperative education, work-study programs, mentorship programs, and industry partnerships.

E. ASOCIO HealthTech Award

1. The nominee must be a legally registered company or organization actively engaged in the delivery of medical or healthcare-related services.



- **2.** Demonstrated achievements in addressing key healthcare challenges through innovation, with measurable improvements in clinical outcomes, patient care, operational efficiency, or costeffectiveness.
- **3.** Outstanding achievements in the use of technology in the healthcare sector, such as hospitals, pharmacies, public health programs, and community health initiatives.

F. ASOCIO Cybersecurity Award

- The nominee must be a legally registered private company or government corporation actively engaged in providing Cybersecurity-related services, solutions, or policy implementation.
- 2. Proven record on promoting policies and /or developing a safe and innovative application or technology focusing on Cybersecurity.
- **3.** Recognized as a market leader or role model in the Cybersecurity industry, with a strong track record of delivering reliable, scalable, and impactful security solutions and services.

G. ASOCIO ESG Award

- 1. The nominee must be a legally registered local company or government organization with demonstrable commitment to Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) principles.
- **2.** Proven implementation of strategies, technologies, and solutions that significantly reduce environmental impact, promote social equity, and uphold strong standards of corporate governance.
- **3.** Recognition as a role model or pioneer in integrating ESG into corporate strategy, risk management, and stakeholder engagement.

H. ASOCIO Start-Up Award

- 1. The nominee must be a legally registered local company operating in a technology-related field.
- 2. Developed product and/or service that is already a success in the market and disrupting the industry with an innovative approach. Demonstrated development of a unique, innovative product, platform, or service that introduces a new approach, solves a significant problem, or redefines existing industry norms.
- **3.** The startup must be a maximum of 3 years old (calculated from the establishment date). Demonstrated potential for rapid growth, scalability, and long-term sustainability.



I. ASOCIO Al Service Provider Award

- 1. The nominee must be a legally registered Information Technology (IT) company with a core business focus on Artificial Intelligence (AI), including Generative AI (Gen AI) and other AIdriven technologies.
- 2. Actively involved in the research, development, deployment, or commercialization of Generative AI or other AI-based solutions. Proven success in delivering innovative, effective, and scalable AI solutions that address real-world challenges, enhance operational efficiencies, or create significant economic or social impact.
- **3.** Proven success in delivering effective, scalable, and high-impact Al solutions that solve pressing business, industrial, or societal challenges.

J. ASOCIO Global Business Service Award

- 1. The nominee must be a legally registered local company with tech-related lines of business services that cover BPO, ITO, Cloud providers, and shared services, including Data centers.
- 2. Proven ability to optimize business processes, enhance operational efficiency, or drive digital transformation for clients across industries or regions.
- **3.** Contributions to enhancing the competitiveness of the local ICT industry in global markets through service excellence, knowledge transfer, or customer success.
